Fear in verse 5 is the Greek word Phobeo = a panic that grips a person causing him to run away, be alarmed, scared, frightened, dismayed, filled with dread, intimidated, anxious and apprehensive.

<u>Fear is a strong motivator</u>. The fear of not having something or someone leads us to making poor choices. It is Just as stifling to be afraid of something or someone. What are you afraid of? Don't answer that question to quickly without some careful reflection because what and whom we fear makes a huge difference as to how we live our life. That's why we are commanded to fear GOD only.

Hebrews 12:28 Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom which cannot be shaken, let us have grace, by which we may serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear. 29 For our God *is* a consuming fire.
