Wiersbe's Three Reminders for this Passage

#1 Christ is Lord of all and we must submit to Him.

#2 A good conscious makes us strong in testing.

#3 Christian baptism, pictured by the flood, illustrates death, burial, and resurrection but does not save the soul.

Baptism: An Appeal to God

1 Peter 3:21-22

So, how does judgment of sin, water baptism and being a disciple intersect?

Baptism: to immerse, dip under or submerge "Baptize into" – because of or due to 1 Cor 10:2, Matthew 3:11, Acts 8:16 & 19:3-5

Urgency of Baptism: 3,000 at Pentecost: Acts 2:41, Towns in Samaria 8:12, Ethiopian Eunuch 8:38, Saul of Tarsus 9:18, Gentiles in Cornelius' House 10:47-48, Lydia's Household 16:15, Philippian Jailer 16:33, 12 Disciples in Ephesus 19:1-6
