The Miracle of Christmas For With God Nothing Will Be Impossible! Luke 1:37

In the beginning God spoke and created the heavens and the earth and all that there is including mankind. All that God created had purpose and value, all was good. Mankind, the man and the woman, were given the privilege of being created in the image of God with the ability to have relationship with God. But man rebelled against their creator unleashing on all of creation death and all evil. Rebellion, sin brings death. There are none who are good, none. All have sinned and fallen short of God's glory. Man is incapable of paying the price for his sin and being reconciled to God, who is our very life. Someone without sin would have to pay the price, so just as our Creator spoke all things into existence He spoke this promise of redemption:

Genesis 3:14 So the Lord God said to the serpent: "Because you have done this, you *are* cursed more than all cattle, and more than every beast of the field; on your belly you shall go, and you shall eat dust all the days of your life. **15** And I will put enmity between you and the woman, and between your seed and **her Seed**; He shall bruise your head, and you shall bruise His heel."

Seed belongs to the man – here God declares that the seed would be in the woman, this would take a supernatural conception! A Redeemer would be born that would end the tyranny of sin and make reconciliation possible.

In Isaiah God declares this promise:

Isaiah 7:14 Therefore the Lord Himself will give you a sign: Behold, the virgin shall conceive and bear a Son, and shall call His name Immanuel.

Virgin – Hebrew word is 'alma – word occurs six other times in the Old Testament and in each instance it denotes virgin (Gen.24:43; Ex.2:8; Ps.68:25; Prov.30:19; Song of Sol.1:3, 6:8). In the Greek translation of the O.T. it is the Greek word parthenos, the same word used in the New Testament.

The Gospel of Luke records for us how this promise was fulfilled:

Luke 1:26 Now in the sixth month the angel Gabriel was sent by God to a city of Galilee named Nazareth, **27** to a virgin betrothed to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David. The virgin's name *was* Mary. **28** And having come in, the angel said to her, "Rejoice, highly favored *one,* the Lord *is* with you; blessed *are*

you among women!" **29** But when she saw *him,* she was troubled at his saying, and considered what manner of greeting this was. **30** Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. **31** And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus. **32** He will be great, and will be called the Son of the Highest; and the Lord God will give Him the throne of His father David. **33** And He will reign over the house of Jacob forever, and of His kingdom there will be no end."

Luke 1:34 Then Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I do not know a man?" 35 And the angel answered and said to her, "*The* Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God. 36 Now indeed, Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age; and this is now the sixth month for her who was called barren. 37 For with God nothing will be impossible." 38 Then Mary said, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word." And the angel departed from her.
