¹⁶You saw me before I was born.

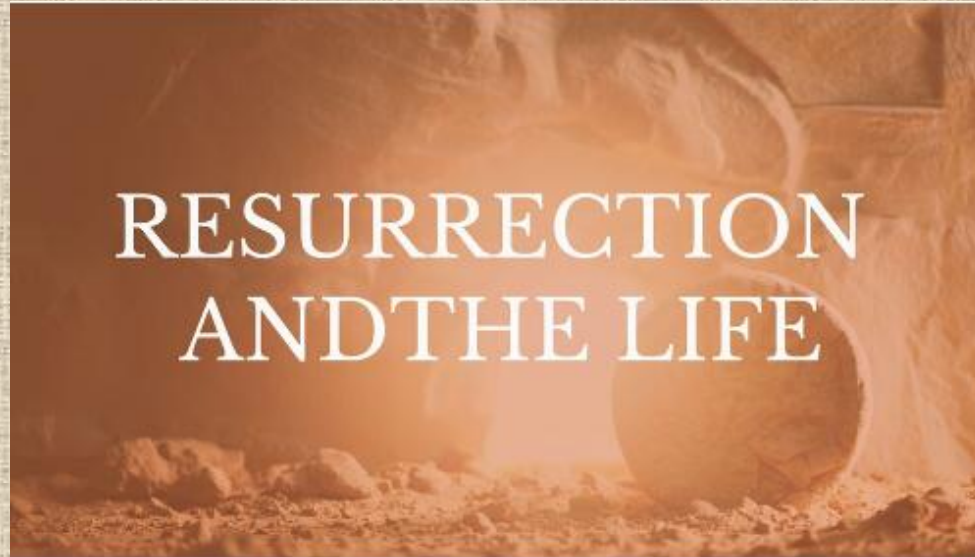
Every day of my life was recorded in your book.
