"for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit."

Word of Wisdom

A supernatural revelation that provides divine insight or direction on how to handle a situation according to God's will.

Purpose: To guide, give direction, or provide a solution from God's perspective.

Word of Knowledge

The Word of Knowledge is a supernatural revelation by the Holy Spirit of **facts or information** that is humanly impossible to know — **past or present**, but not the future.

Purpose:

- To bring understanding,
- Uncover hidden truth, or reveal specifics about a situation in order to bring about repentance or healing
- God to demonstrate that He has an intimate knowledge of a situation.

Evangelism

A spiritual ability to effectively share the Gospel and lead others to faith in Jesus Christ.

Spiritual Discernment

• The process of seeking and recognizing God's will or guidance in a particular situation or throughout life.

• It involves looking for the deeper spiritual significance of events, choices, or experiences, and distinguishing between influences that are from God, those that are not

Spiritual Discernment

Asking the question "God what do you think about this?"
