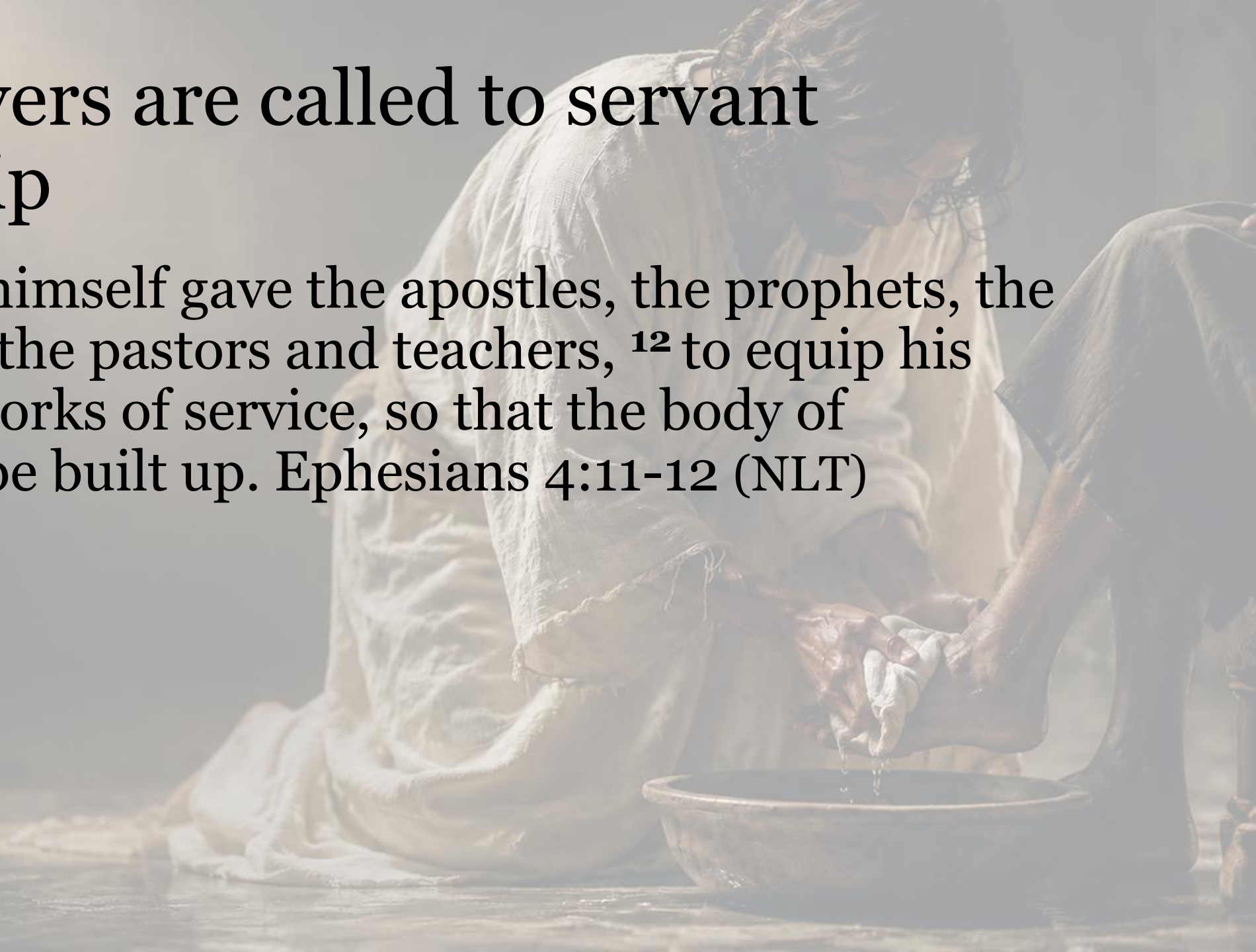
Jesus Redefined Leadership

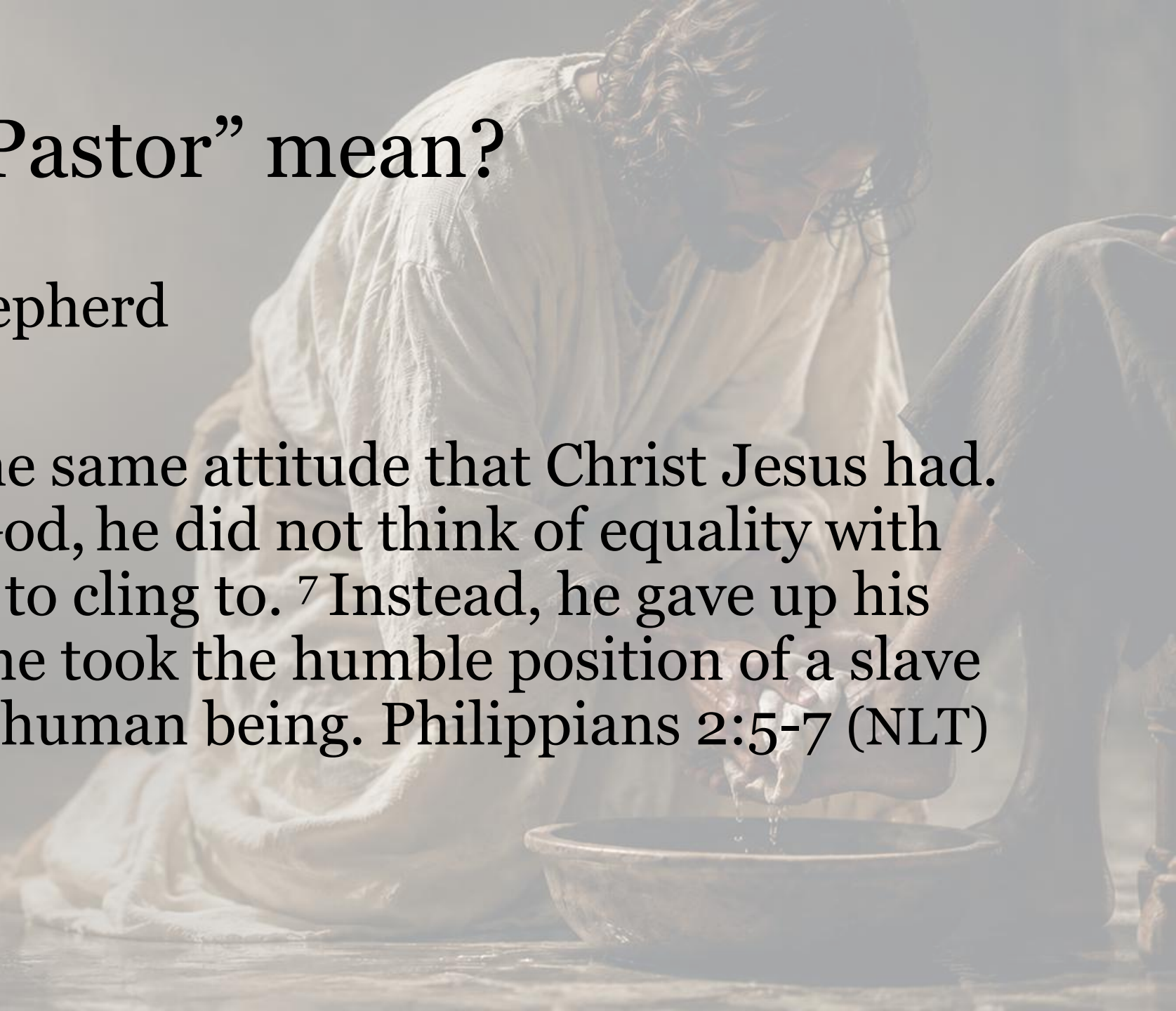
