THE POWER OF PRAYER AND WORSHIP

HOLY B

Ephesians 6:18-20 NASB

¹⁸ With every prayer and request, pray at all times in the Spirit, and with this in view, be alert with all perseverance and *every* request for all the saints, ¹⁹and pray on my behalf, that speech may be given to me in the opening of my mouth, to make known with boldness the mystery of the gospel, ²⁰for which I am an ambassador in chains; that in *proclaiming* it I may speak boldly, as I ought to speak.

Ephesians 6:18-20 NASB

...pray at all times in the Spirit.

- **Pray:** προσευχόμενοι (proseuchomenoi)
Strong's 4336: To pray, pray for, offer prayer. From pros and euchomai; to pray to God, i.e. Supplicate...
- **To worship.**

Proseuchomenoi - Is This TONGUES?!

- Proseuchomenoi refers broadly to the act of prayer, not to the mode (like tongues). It is to be guided by the Lord.
- However, when Paul adds “in the Spirit” (pneumati ἐν Πνεύματι), it includes spiritual prayer forms such as tongues.
- So tongues **CAN** be a form of proseuchomai, but proseuchomenoi does not equal tongues itself.

Roman 8:26-27 NASB

26 Now in the same way the Spirit also helps our weakness; for we do not know what to pray for as we should, but the Spirit Himself intercedes for *us* with **groanings** too deep for words; **27** and He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit is, because He intercedes for the saints according to *the will of God*.

Paul and Silas

Acts 16:9-34

Summary of Acts 16:9-24

- Verse 9: God gives a vision for them to go to Macedonia.
- Verse 11: Lydia Converted to the Lord.
- Verse 16: A slave woman with the spirit of divination drives them nuts.
- Verse 18: Paul casts the spirit out of her.
- Verse 19: The owners who profited from the woman turn Paul and Silas in to the chief magistrates.
- Verse 22-24: They are stripped of their clothing and beaten with rods and thrown in Prison wrongfully.

Acts 16:25-28 NASB

25 Now about midnight Paul and Silas were praying and singing hymns of praise to God, and the prisoners were listening to them; **26** and suddenly there was a great earthquake, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken; and immediately all the doors were opened, and everyone's chains were unfastened. **27** When the jailer awoke and saw the prison doors opened, he drew *his* sword and was about to kill himself, thinking that the prisoners had escaped. **28** But Paul called out with a loud voice, saying, "Do not harm yourself, for we are all here!"



Acts 16:29-32 NASB


