





# We Were Never Meant to Do Life Alone


God designed us for:

The Christian life was never designed to be lived in isolation.

Following Jesus is personal—but it was never meant to be private.

**The enemy loves isolation because isolated people are **vulnerable**.**

**When people become isolated, they become easier targets.**

The Apostle Paul writes:

“Now you are the body of Christ, and each one of you is a part of it.” — 1 Corinthians 12:27

Notice two truths:

We are ONE body. Every person has a role  
No one is insignificant in the kingdom of God.

**\*Paul goes on to explain that the body cannot function properly if parts are disconnected from one another.**

## Hebrews 10:23-25 NLT

<sup>23</sup>Let us hold resolutely to the hope we profess, for He who promised is faithful. <sup>24</sup>And **let us consider how to spur one another on to love and good deeds.** <sup>25</sup>Let us not neglect meeting together, as some have made a habit, but **let us encourage one another**, and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
