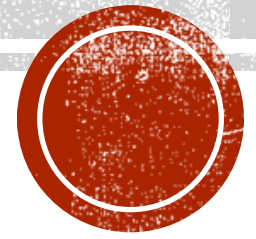

# THREE BAPTISMS

1. Baptism of Salvation – We belong to God (identity)
2. Baptism by Water – We publicly show our faith (sign)
3. Baptism in the Holy Spirit – We live it out with power (experience)

Greek word: Baptizo = to dip, to immerse, to submerge

Root: Bapto = to stain (as with dye)



# 1 CORINTHIANS 4:20-21 (NLT)

# BAPTISM OF SALVATION

Some of us are Jews,

the same Spirit. 1  
Corinthians 12:13 (NLT)



# RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT AT SALVATION

<sup>19</sup> That Sunday evening the disciples were meeting behind locked doors because they were afraid of the Jewish leaders. Suddenly, Jesus was standing there among them! “Peace be with you,” he said. <sup>20</sup> As he spoke, he showed them the wounds in his hands and his side. They were filled with joy when they saw the Lord! <sup>21</sup> Again he said, “Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I am sending you.” <sup>22</sup> **Then he breathed on them and said, “Receive the Holy Spirit. John 20:19-22 (NLT)**



# BAPTISM BY WATER

<sup>41</sup> Those who believed what Peter said were baptized and added to the church that day—about 3,000 in all.

Acts 2:41 (NLT)



# BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

<sup>29</sup> ...John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Look! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. <sup>32</sup> Then John testified, “I saw the Holy Spirit descending like a dove from heaven and resting upon him. <sup>33</sup> I didn’t know he was the one, but when God sent me to baptize with water, he told me, ‘**The one on whom you see the Spirit descend and rest is the one who will baptize with the Holy Spirit.**’ <sup>34</sup> I saw this happen to Jesus, so I testify that he is the Chosen One of God.” John 1:29, 32-34 (NLT)

**Jesus is the one that baptizes in the Holy Spirit**



# WHAT ROLE DOES THE HOLY SPIRIT PLAY?

## Comforter/Advocate/Helper

“But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in my name, he will teach you all things and bring to your remembrance all that I have said to you.” John 14:26 (ESV)

## Teacher/Guide

“As for you, the anointing which you received from Him abides in you, and you have no need for anyone to teach you; but as His anointing teaches you about all things, and is true and is not a lie, and just as it has taught you, you abide in Him.” 1 John 2:28 (NLT)



# WHAT ROLE DOES THE HOLY SPIRIT PLAY?

## Helps us pray

<sup>26</sup> And the Holy Spirit helps us in our weakness. For example, we don't know what God wants us to pray for. But the Holy Spirit prays for us with groanings that cannot be expressed in words. Romans 8:26-27 (NLT)

## Conviction of sin

“And when he comes, he will convict the world concerning sin and righteousness and judgment.” John 16:8 (ESV)



# THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT

<sup>4</sup> Once when he was eating with them, he commanded them, “Do not leave Jerusalem until the **Father sends you the gift he promised**, as I told you before. <sup>5</sup> John baptized with water, but **in just a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.**” <sup>8</sup> But you **will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you.** And you will be my witnesses, telling people about me everywhere. <sup>9</sup> After saying this, he was taken up into a cloud while they were watching, and they could no longer see him.

Acts 1:4-5,8-9 (NLT)



# EXAMPLE OF HOLY SPIRIT BAPTISM

<sup>44</sup> Even as Peter was saying these things, the Holy Spirit fell upon all who were listening to the message. <sup>45</sup> The Jewish believers who came with Peter were amazed that the gift of the Holy Spirit had been poured out on the Gentiles, too. <sup>46</sup> For they heard them speaking in other tongues and praising God.

Acts 10:44-46 (NLT)



# RECEIVING THE BAPTISM IN THE HOLY SPIRIT

1. We pray in faith and receive in faith
2. Jesus is the one that baptizes us in the Holy Spirit
3. It is not measured by emotion or feeling
