

Isaiah 6:1-8

## When you get a clear vision of God:

### 1. You will SEE His GLORY and HOLINESS.

<sup>1</sup> In the year of King Uzziah's death, I saw the Lord seated on a high, elevated throne. The hem of his robe filled the temple. <sup>2</sup> Seraphs stood over him; each one had six wings. With two wings they covered their faces, with two they covered their feet, and they used the remaining two to fly. <sup>3</sup> They called out to one another, "Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Heaven's Armies! His majestic splendor fills the entire earth!" <sup>4</sup> The sound of their voices shook the door frames, and the temple was filled with smoke.

### 2. You will SEE your SIN and LOWLINESS.

<sup>5</sup> I said, "Woe to me! I am destroyed, for my lips are contaminated by sin, and I live among people whose lips are contaminated by sin. My eyes have seen the king, the Lord of Heaven's Armies."

### 3. God will SAVE you.

<sup>6</sup> But then one of the seraphs flew toward me. In his hand was a hot coal he had taken from the altar with tongs. <sup>7</sup> He touched my mouth with it and said, "Look, this coal has touched your lips. Your evil is removed; your sin is forgiven."

### 4. God will SEND you.

<sup>8</sup> I heard the voice of the Lord say, "Whom will I send? Who will go on our behalf?" I answered, "Here I am, send me!"

## DIGGING DEEPER

### REVELATION 22:1-5

- What do you imagine when you think about eternity? What emotions do you feel when you think about it?
- What do you think the "water of life" symbolizes (v. 1)? What are its characteristics? What is its source?
- Why is it significant that the tree of life will yield fruit every month of the year (v. 2, **Ezekiel 47:12**)? How is that different than most fruit trees we are accustomed to today? What hope does this give us?
- Who will be able to live in the city described in this passage and eat from the tree of life (**Revelation 2:72**, **Timothy 1:10**)?
- What does it mean that "there will no longer be any curse" (v. 3a, **Revelation 21:3**)?
- What will be the relationship between the Lord's servants and God (v. 3b-5)? How is this similar and how is it different to how Isaiah interacted with God in **Isaiah 6:1-8**?
- What is the most important thing about where and how we will spend eternity (v. 4, **Revelation 7:15**, **Revelation 21:3**, **Jeremiah 32:36-41**)? Based on what is most important in eternity, how should we live here and now? What should our vision be focused on?
- How does seeing God (partial vision now and complete vision in eternity, **1 Corinthians 13:12**) relate to worship?
- How will we "live out" our relationship with God in eternity (v. 5b, **Daniel 7:27**)? What do you think this means? How should we live out our relationship with God today (**Isaiah 6:8**, **Mark 16:15**)?
