#### LITERAL INTERPRETATION

### "Jacob wrestled With God."

Fig. **"Like Jacob, we all** Have wrestled with God.

Figurative Examples:

"Owns a cattle on a thousand hills."

"But seventy times seven."

"This is my body, broken for you."

#### "Greet one another with a holy kiss." Romans 16:16

Culture aids context Culture aids application

#### **Holy Kiss?**

[Cultural Equivalent: America's welcoming handshake.]

#### **GRAMMATICAL** INTERPRETATION

#### "Teach your children these things." Deut. 11:19

Grammatical Tense: **"TEACH"** [root: like sharpening a knife]

#### Grammatical Usage: **"BAPTIZE"** [baptizo: transliteration of the Latin word meaning "immerse"]

Grammatical Meaning "AMEN" [to agree, to say 'so be it']

### "There is nothing new under the sun." Ecclesiastes 1:9

#### **Consider Genre**

 Poetry: this is cynical language written in prose.

#### Narrative

 Author writing style and specific goals

Do you understand what you are reading? And he said, **"How can I, unless someone guides me?"** 

And he invited Philip to come up and sit with him. Now the passage of the Scripture that he was reading was this:

#### Scroll of Isaiah 53:7-8

"Like a sheep he was led to the slaughter and like a lamb before its shearer is silent, so he opens not his mouth. In his humiliation justice was denied him. Who can describe his generation? For his life is taken away from the earth."



And the eunuch said to Philip, "About whom, **I ask you**, does the prophet say this, about himself or about someone else?"

Then Philip opened his mouth, and beginning with **this Scripture** he told him the good news about Jesus.

PIONEERS
