But One Body

For the body does not consist of one member but of many.

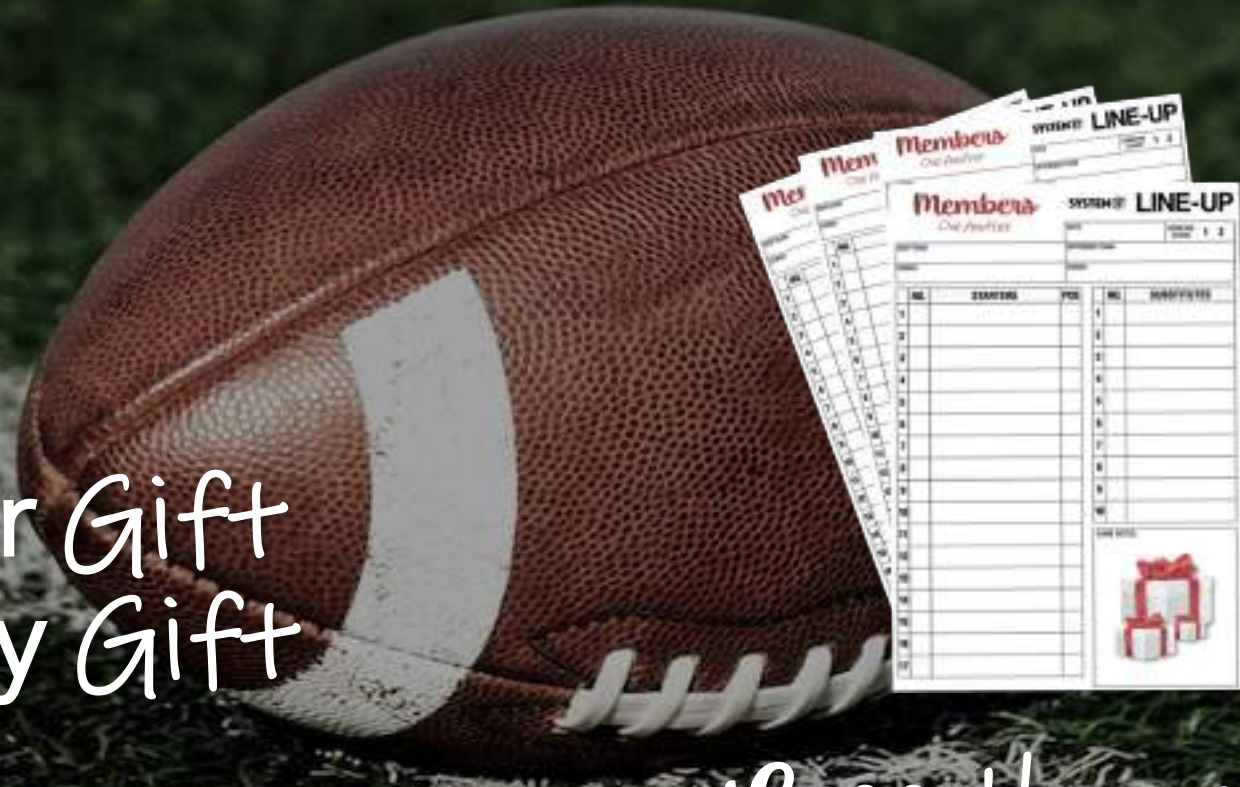
