









22 Then Moses made Israel set out from the Red Sea, and they went into the wilderness of Shur.

A deep, often involuntary expression of distress, longing, or pain.

- Remembers God's Faithfulness
- Proper perspective
- Dependence on God
- Hope & redemption

Grumbling

Complaining or murmuring in a discontented or rebellious manner.

- Distorts the past
- Exaggerates the present
- Rooted in rebellion
- Lacks faith

"Oh Lord, I would like something different."




Sometimes we get what we asked for, but miss out on what God could have done

on the fifteenth day of the second month after they had departed from the land of Egypt."




Exodus 16 2 And the whole congregation of the people of Israel grumbled against Moses and Aaron in the wilderness, WILDERNESS OF SIN






