






COMMON RESPONSES o apologics



THE GOAL OF APOLOGETICS IS GOD SAVING SOULS, NOT WINNING ARGUMENTS.

Evangelism

is the verbalization of the gospel message.

Similarities

Goal of Bringing People to Faith

Both aim to bring people to know and accept Jesus Christ as Lord.

Communication of the Gospel

Each involves explaining and sharing the message of the gospel.

Support for Believers

Both strengthen and encourage the faith of Christians.

Evangelism

is the verbalization of the gospel message.

Differences

Method of Approach

Focuses on intellectual defense of the faith.

Primary Focus

Addresses questions and challenges to Christianity.

Function in Ministry

Often serves as "pre-evangelism."

Method of Approach

Proclaims the gospel and invites belief.


Primary Focus

Emphasizes sharing the good news and salvation.

Function in Ministry

Directly invites a response to the gospel.



- We gently correct opponents.






1 Peter 3:15-16

Tactics For apologetics

ASK QUESTIONS & LISTEN ACTIVELY

E.



Ask questions to understand the other person's viewpoint better. For example, "What do you mean by that?" or "Can you explain that further?"

Reflect back what you've heard to ensure understanding, e.g., "So, you're saying that...?"
