“Show yourself a man”

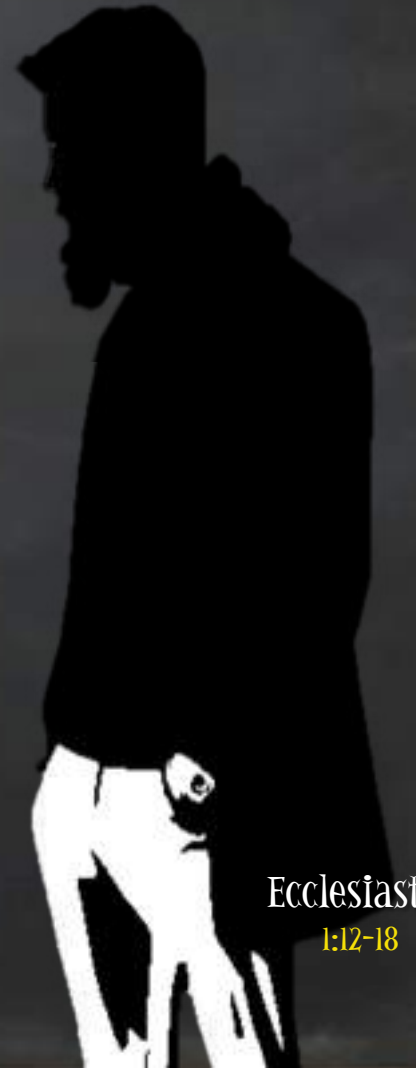

increases sorrow.





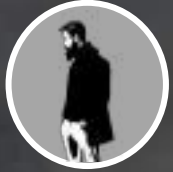
