


But when **Paul** wished to go in among the **crowd**, the disciples would not let him.






Some of the crowd prompted Alexander, whom the Jews had put forward. And Alexander, motioning with his hand, wanted to make a defense to the crowd.

But when they recognized that he was a Jew, for about two hours they all cried out with one voice, "**Great is Artemis of the Ephesians!**"



Nahum's recovery or lack thereof is literally in God's hands, but there is no better place to be. It is ours to wait and watch and pray and trust.

The doctors and nurses say that they have seen patients in Nahum's condition improve and be rehabilitated to varying degrees of ability, they have seen others who haven't improved or recovered any quality of life. There is no ability at this point to predict what will happen. At least, the doctors are unable to predict what will happen. I have a little bit of the inside scoop based on Romans 8:28—"And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to his purpose." God will glorify Himself, and He will do what is best for us. That's enough; more than enough, in fact.
