THE VINEYARD


Hear another parable. There was a a master of a house who planted a vineyard and put a fence around it and dug a winepress in it and built a tower and leased it to tenants and went to another country.

THE VINEYARD And the tenants took his servants and beat one, killed another, and stoned another. Matthew 21:33-42


THE VINEYARD Again he sent other servants, more than the first. And they did the same to them. Matthew 21:33-42







CORNERSTONE


"The stone that the builders rejected has become the cornerstone; this was the Lord's doing, and it is marvelous in our eyes."














7 Ways Jesus prepared His disciples for... PERSECUTION?

1. PLAN WITH PRUDENCE

"Be wise as serpents..."

2. REMAIN INNOCENT

"Be innocent as doves..."

3. ANTICIPATE ACCUSATION

"Beware of men, for they will deliver you over to the courts."

4. DO NOT BE ANXIOUS

"For what you are to say will be given to you."

5. EXPECT TO BE HATED

"They will hate you because of me."

6. KEEP GOING

"Flee to the next town."

7. AWAIT A 'GREAT REWARD'

"The Son of Man is coming."

SIMON: crucified in Persia

THOMAS: stabbed by a spear in India
