#### 1. We Worship a Powerful God

*“God hath spoken once; twice have I heard this; that power belongeth unto God.” (Psalm 62:11)*

##### A. His power is seen in His awesome creation.

*“The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament sheweth his handywork.” (Psalm 19:1)*

*“By the word of the Lord were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.” (Psalm 33:6)*

B. His power is seen in His authority.

*“Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all.” (1 Chronicles 29:12)*

C. His power is seen in His ability.

1. He is able to do anything—omnipotence.

*“I know that thou canst do every thing, and that no thought can be withholden from thee.” (Job 42:2)*

*“But Jesus beheld them, and said unto them, With men this is impossible; but with God all things are possible.” (Matthew 19:26)*

2. He knows everything—omniscience.

*“For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.” (1 John 3:20)*

3. He is everywhere—omnipresence.

*“The eyes of the Lord are in every place, beholding the evil and the good.” (Proverbs 15:3)*

*“Can any hide himself in secret places that I shall not see him? saith the Lord. Do not I fill heaven and earth? saith the Lord.” (Jeremiah 23:24)*

## 2. We Worship a Perfect God

*“As for God, his way is perfect: the word of the Lord is tried: he is a buckler to all those that trust in him.” (Psalm 18:30)*

A. He is perfect in His oneness.

*“For though there be that are called gods, whether in heaven or in earth, (as there be gods many, and lords many,) But to us there is but one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we in him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, by whom are all things, and we by him.” (1 Corinthians 8:5–6)*

B. He is perfect in His holiness.

*“Exalt the Lord our God, and worship at his holy hill; for the Lord our God is holy.” (Psalm 99:9)*

*“Because it is written, Be ye holy; for I am holy.” (1 Peter 1:16)*

C. He is perfect in His righteousness  
and justice.

*“...Shall not the Judge of all the earth do right?” (Genesis 18:25)*

*“He is the Rock, his work is perfect: for all his ways are judgment: a God of truth and without iniquity, just and right is he.” (Deuteronomy 32:4)*

D. He is perfect in His faithfulness.

*“For I am the Lord, I change not...” (Malachi 3:6)*

*“Jesus Christ the same yesterday, and to day, and for ever.” (Hebrews 13:8)*

**3. We Worship a Personal God**

*“For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end.” (Jeremiah 29:11)*

A. His personality is seen in His titles.

1. God

*“In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth.” (Genesis 1:1)*

2. I Am

*“And God said unto Moses, I AM THAT I AM: and he said, Thus shalt thou say unto the children of Israel, I AM hath sent me unto you.” (Exodus 3:14)*

3. Jehovah

*“And I appeared unto Abraham, unto Isaac, and unto Jacob, by the name of God Almighty, but by my name JEHOVAH was I not known to them.” (Exodus 6:3)*

4. The God of gods and Lord of lords

*“For the Lord your God is God of gods, and Lord of lords, a great God, a mighty, and a terrible, which regardeth not persons, nor taketh reward.” (Deuteronomy 10:17)*

5. Heavenly Father

*“Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?” (Matthew 6:26)*

B. His personality is seen in His trinity.

*“For there are three that bear record in heaven, the Father, the Word, and the Holy Ghost: and these three are one.” (1 John 5:7)*

C. His personality is seen in His tender care.

*“But God, who is rich in mercy, for his great love wherewith he loved us, That in the ages to come he might shew the exceeding riches of his grace in his kindness toward us through Christ Jesus.” (Ephesians 2:4, 7)*

*“Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.” (1 Peter 5:7)*
