1. At the beginning of the message, you were given a model of what one of Paul's churches would have looked like. How does this impact your view of the church? How does this affect your view of Grace?

2. What areas of your life are being stretched or purified as we go through Galatians?

3. Matt talked about things that get mixed in with Christianity. (Example Jesus plus something else, Grace mixed with some law). Do you see any "pollution" in your idea of Christianity?

4. Discuss knowing God as ABBA. How can we grow in our relationship with God as ABBA? (in both reverence and intimacy).

APPLICATION

This week be intentional in spending time learning what it means to be a son. Spend time learning the fear of the Lord. Learn to know God as ABBA. See where the Holy Spirit leads you. Think about sharing what you learned with your small group.
