- 2. Why do you think Jesus referenced two gentiles (Zarephath and Naaman) while teaching about justification instead of the Israelites?
- 3. Any time we insert some sort of merit for our justification, we defile the Gospel. What do you think about this statement? How does it defile the Gospel?
- 4. This week, the question we face is, "Where does your faith lie?" Where do we get our idea of being justified with God? Is it in Christ alone? Or is it in a combination of things?

APPLICATION

Explore your mind this week and see if you think there are things you do or say that make God like you more. Do you think there are things you do or say that make God like you less? How do these questions and thoughts line up with what it means to be justified with God?
