3. In the lead up to the parable, the expert in the law asks Jesus, "who is my neighbor?" What is your first thought when you think about who is your neighbor? How can you expand that definition?

4. The Bible's definition of love is that love is an action (not an emotion). When you act in love toward others, you walk in the freedom of the abundant life God intends for you. How would you explain to someone else that love leads to freedom?
