INTRODUCTION

This week in the final message of the 2-part series Call of the Seer, we will be discussing the gift of prophecy, and its role in the life of a believer. As followers of Christ this gift is given for us to encourage, build up, & comfort others.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

1. What did you see last week when you paid attention? Was paying attention difficult?
2. What did you know about prophecy before this series?
3. Have you ever heard the voice of God? This could be in a dream, or an impression to tell someone something? If so, can you share your experience?
4. Now that you understand prophecy is a gift that is available to all believers do you have an earnest desire to grow in the gift?
5. What do you think the greatest benefit of operating in the gift of prophecy is for the church?

APPLICATION

Identify a place where God can use prophecy to bless others. Is it at home? Your workplace? Your friendships? Ask God to reveal one thing to you that you can share with another person. As Lisa said, prophecy is a gift that takes practice!

Icebreakers

Pick one of the icebreaker questions below and go around in a circle (starting with the leader) and have everyone answer. (If you have new members or guests have each person introduce themselves.)

1. What is your favorite season of the year? Why? What makes it special for you?
2. Do you speak a second language? What is it? How did you learn it?
3. What was your favorite subject in school? Do you have a teacher that you still remember?

PRAYER (20-30 min)

Ask for prayer requests. Pray that each person will open up to receiving the gift of prophecy. Ask for other requests, and if someone in the group has a prophetic word about a prayer request, leave space for that to be shared.
