We Win – Matt Slocum

Sermon Text: Revelation 20:4-15

AGENDA

PRAYER/MINISTRY TIME (20-30 min)

Ask for prayer requests. Ask for specific needs of group members. Be open to any word of knowledge or prophetic word you might receive from the Holy Spirit.

MESSAGE INTRODUCTION

This week our sermon questions will be focused on the millennium reign. The church doesn't talk much of Jesus' return but in Revelation 20 John tells us that Jesus is coming back and there will be a kingdom established on the earth. The question is are you ready? How should followers of Christ understand the system of the world we live in and what question was John answering for the church about Jesus' return?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

1. Last week we were asked if it was hard to see people living in ways we perceive as "evil". Grace is the only thing that draws people to God. Were you able to find some practical ways to show grace to others this past week.
2. Was there anything that really resonated with you from the message this week?
3. Today we are told that we need to be ready at a moment's notice. What would it look like for us to live a life that is always ready for the return of Jesus? Are there things might we leave out of life or others we might add?
4. According to Matt, what is the most important things we are to understand about the millennium? (Hint: see the sermon title). What difference does that make in our life?
5. We are not fighting for a victory. We are fighting from a victory that has already been won. How might our lives be different if we live from a position of victory? What is something practical that would be different in our life? Is this how the world lives?

Icebreakers

Pick one of the icebreaker questions below and go around in a circle (starting with the leader) and have everyone answer. (If you have new members or guests have each person introduce themselves.)

1. Who is your favorite musician or musical group? Have you ever heard them live?
2. What is your least favorite household chore? Why?
3. If I won the lottery, I would _____ ?

6. The only way we can be defeated is if we give up and relinquish the victory that is already ours. Is there an area in your life where you are battling, tired, and close to giving up? Consider sharing with the group so they can help lift you up and encourage you.
