MESSAGE INTRODUCTION

In this week's message, Pastor Matt unveils three primary functions of the law. If you've ever struggled with legalism, or wondered is there such a thing as too much grace, **The Purpose of the Law**, will bring much needed revelation and freedom.

Icebreakers

Pick one of the icebreaker questions below and go around in a circle (starting with the leader) and have everyone answer. (If you have new members or guests have each person introduce themselves.)

- 1. What is something that needs to be included in any BBQ?
- 2. Have you already started getting Christmas decorations out?
- 3. Where is your favorite place to see the changing colors of leaves in the Fall?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

1. At the beginning of the sermon, Antinomianism and Legalism were defined. (**Antinomianism** – doctrine according to which Christians are freed by grace from the necessity of obeying the Mosaic Law. **Legalism** – the idea that by doing good works or by obeying the law, a person earns and merits salvation.)

Have you felt tempted to fall into one of those categories regarding Grace?

- 2. How can we as believers do a better job of communicating the message of Grace without leading people into the confusion that comes from the ideas of Antinomianism and Legalism
- 3. Discuss applying the wisdom in the Old Testament law to our lives today. (This can be about specific rules or just a general discussion).
- 4. Has your view of the reason why God gave the law changed? How do you see that change impacting your walk with God?

APPLICATION

Are there ways you might be behaving like the Galatians and are are adding things (either intentionally or unintentionally) to the Gospel you first believed in? Is Jesus plus nothing enough? Think and pray on this throughout this week and see if the Holy Spirit brings to mind anything that might be watering down or altering the Gospel.
