MESSAGE INTRODUCTION

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

- 1. Last week, we were asked to consider our words and ask ourselves if they were bringing freedom, redemption, and grace. What did you discover?
- 2. What impacted you the most from this week's sermon?
- 3. "Gossip is attractive because it satisfies our need to be right." Explore this statement. Do you struggle with a need to be right?
- 4. "Gossip hides behind virtuous titles." What titles have you found gossip lurking behind? Did you realize it at the time?
- 5. "Gossip strips our prayers of power by misdirecting them." Have you withheld from forming a conclusion until you've prayed? What tips do you have for those of us who struggle with this?

6. Gossip has affected all of us, either by participating or being the topic of discussion. However, there is healing and forgiveness for us in Christ. Take some time now to pray specifically over group members who request it.

APPLICATION

Much like last week, consider your words. Are you participating in gossip? Is there someone in your life who is trying to get you to gossip with them? Be aware and remind yourself you don't have to associate with gossip.
