### **MESSAGE INTRODUCTION**

The Israelites had every reason to trust God. We have every reason to trust Him. This week, in Matt's message entitled **This Is Movement**, we are exploring the idea that when God speaks, we go.

# Icebreakers

Pick one of the icebreaker questions below and go around in a circle (starting with the leader) and have everyone answer. (If you have new members or guests have each person introduce themselves.)

1. How old were you when you stopped believing in Santa Claus? (Or maybe you still believe in the "Big Guy"?

2. Do you leave out milk and cookies for Santa or something else?

3. Do you have any special New Year's traditions?

1. Last week you were asked what would happen if you adopted an attitude of humility? What might be a visible change if that happened? Did the Holy Spirit show you any area of your life where you need to adapt an attitude of humility?

2. What is something special you took from the message this week?

3. What were the reports brought back to Israel from the spies who were sent out to explore the Promised Land? What two different assessments did the spies report back to the people?

4. Faith is not blind; it sees. Unbelief is blind. Faith is not about our background, our pedigree, or our qualifications, but rather is about whether we will trust God. Can you think of any other times in the Bible where faith, or lack of faith, is shown? Do you have any personal examples you would like to share?

5. Caleb and Joshua give us a picture of the faithfulness of Jesus. Read Numbers 4:9. What does it mean when it says, "they are bread for us"? How does this understanding change how we approach our battles?

#### APPLICATION

During the message, Matt asked us to press the "reset" button and go back to what God had told us to do. The challenge for us is to hear His voice and then do what He says to do. Now! Take some time to listen for the voice of God. What is He saying to you? What is your response going to be?
