MESSAGE INTRODUCTION

As we go through the second part of **Re-Building the**

House, we are learning some new things and also re-

learning some things we already knew. One thing we will

learn is that not everything we have learned up to this point is TOV, or good. Let's listen to the Holy Spirit as we dive into the message this week and see what He is wanting to teach us.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

1. Last week you were asked to take some time to reflect and see if you are bringing any toxic behaviors or attitudes to New Wine Church. Was there anything the Holy Spirit brought to mind?
2. What is something that stood out to you from the message this week?
3. What does it mean for New Wine Church to be a "House of Learning"? Are you contributing to the church being a house of learning? How might you do better?
4. Why does being a "House of Belonging" mean more than just a church built on community?
5. How does a "House of Freedom" bring about a "House of Miracles"? Read Luke 13:10-13, 16 and discuss how the sabbath is about freedom, and freedom brings the miraculous.

APPLICATION

Take some time to think about the direction your affections are pointed or are they turned outward to God and others? Let it sink in that we belong to something greater than ourselves.

Pick one of the icebreaker questions below and go around in a circle (starting with the leader) and have everyone answer. (If you have new members or guests have each person introduce themselves.)

2. What was one of your favorite Christmas gifts ever?
