- 3. What are some things that Jesus said or did to let them know He was God? (Things that only God could say or do.)
- 4. Why do you think it's important that Jesus "called His shots"? Do you think it had any impact on the disciples and what was to come? How might it have impacted them regarding His promises of things to come?

Take some time this week and be intentional in the way you honor Jesus. Try to move past just going through the motions and give Jesus the honor He truly deserves.
