MESSAGE INTRODUCTION

This week Matt continues the series 8th Day People. In this week's message entitled Forgiveness, we explore the Kingdom idea that forgiveness brings freedom. 8th Day People have experienced forgiveness, and they need to forgive.

Pick one of the icebreaker questions below and go around in a circle (starting with the leader) and have everyone answer. (If you have new members or guests have each person introduce themselves.)

- 1. As a small group, can you name all the US Presidents?
- 2. Did you get to enjoy a day off work for President's Day, or was it just another day at work?
- 3. Is there an inspirational quote that has been particularly meaningful to you? What is it?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

- 1. What was impactful to you from this week's message?
- 2. How did Jesus view what he was doing on the cross regarding the debt humanity owed?
- 3. Read Matthew 18:15-17. Discuss what forgiveness is NOT and what that means practically for us when we forgive.
- 4. If comfortable, share about the forgiveness moment during communion at the end of service.

APPLICATION

Spend time this week asking the Holy Spirit to show you any areas of your life where you are living with unforgiveness. If the Holy Spirit revealed anything to you, pray for His strength to allow you to forgive and receive freedom. Be prepared to share with your group.
