- 3. What would happen if we took all the effort expended in covering up our sin and just did what He asked us to do? How far along in our walk with God would we be?
- 4. Are there times when we proclaim to "fear" or follow God but our actions don't bear it out? (We are found sleeping like Jonah). What should be our reaction when the mirror comes up and we become aware of that?
- 5. What does it mean to "play church"? Be honest with yourself. What do you see when you look in the mirror?

APPLICATION

Is there a "Jonah" in your boat causing the storms all around you? What about in your phone? In the story of Jonah, who is suffering because of his decisions? Are there people around us suffering because of our decisions? What should we do when faced with this reality? Reflect on the message this week. Pray about what word God is speaking to you. Instead of running, surrender yourself totally to God. Have you been "playing church"? Now is the time the Lord wants you to wake up!
