## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)**

- 3. Read Titus 2:11-12. How does grace actually instruct and teach us to deny ungodliness and worldly desires?
- 4. Read 2 Peter 3:3-9. What does this communicate to us?
- 5. How does fixing our hope on His return contribute to holy living in the present?

### **APPLICATION**

Spend some time this week and think about the return of Jesus. Is His return something you long for? Or is it something you try not to think about? How should the work of grace affect your thoughts on His return? How can you shift your thoughts to an expectation and longing for His return?
