# **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)**

- 1. What is something that stuck out to you from the message this week?
- 2. With the understanding that we are to function as people who bring the culture of heaven to earth. How can we do that as a small group, as individuals, in our families, work environment, etc.?
- 3. We tend to leave the Gospel of Grace for more familiar structures of thought and behavior. Where are areas of your life where you see this happening? How can we consistently check ourselves to ensure our Gospel (good news) is the good news of grace?
- 4. Paul is clear there are other "gospels" that are false. Discuss these questions from the end of the message.
  - Does this Gospel cause me to fix my eyes exclusively on Jesus?
  - Does this Gospel empower me to overcome sin?
  - Does this Gospel release Joy and Peace?
  - Does this Gospel set free?

Continue to think about these final questions this week and see if the Holy Spirit shows you any place in your life where you might fall short when answering any of these questions. Pray for the Holy Spirit to work in your life to keep you focused on the true gospel. The gospel of grace.
