### MESSAGE INTRODUCTION

This week we continue our sermon series in Ephesians. In his message this week entitled, The Now And Not Yet Of

Redemption, Grant explores how we have been saved, we are being saved, and we will be saved. In this message we discover the amazing guarantee we have in Christ, sealed by the Holy Spirit. The indwelling of the Holy Spirit is a foretaste of heaven – a brief, but powerful experience of the nearness, peace, and love of God. How is all this possible? Let's dive in and find out.

## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)**

- 1. Last week you were asked how you were doing in submitting yourself to God's will. Did the Holy Spirit show you areas where maybe you still trying to hold on and do things your own way, under your own power?
- 2. What stood out to you most from this message, and why?
- 3. The Greek word arrabōn (pledge/down payment) was explained as something of value given to guarantee fulfillment. How does this deepen your confidence in God's promises? Why do you think God gives us the Holy Spirit as a pledge if He never breaks His word anyway? Can you recall a time when you felt the Holy Spirit's assurance or nearness a "foretaste" of eternity?
- 4. Romans 8:23 speaks of the redemption of our bodies. How does the promise of a redeemed, glorified body encourage you in your current struggles or pain? Why is it significant that our eternal existence will be embodied not just spiritual?
- 5. "You have been redeemed, you are being redeemed, and you will be redeemed." How do you see these three stages of redemption playing out in your life?

Pick one of the icebreaker questions below and go around in a circle (starting with the leader) and have everyone answer. (If you have new members or guests have each person introduce themselves.)

- 2, If you had to eat the same food every day for a month, what would it be?

6. In what ways can the church be a "foretaste of heaven" to those who gather?
