3. What is the weirdest job you have heard of?

Pastor Matt discusses the radicalness of Grace in his sermon, **A House of Grace**. We will be discussing what grace actually means and unpacking how it can be so easy to stand on the side of the accusers when someone fails or falls, yet grace stands with the accused regardless of the circumstance. It isn't always easy to give grace, but it is always aligned with the heart of Christ when we do.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

1. Last week, you were asked to think of steps you could take to know God more and be known by Him. Share what steps you took.

2. What stood out to you from this week's sermon?

3. The primary thing God wants us to know about Him is in Exodus 34:6 - He is full of mercy and grace. What does this mean to you?

4. Grace will mess with you. Have you seen grace extended when it didn't fit with your ideas of right and wrong? How did that make you feel?

5. Grace stands with the accused. Has there been a time when you or someone you know was accused? Did someone stand with you? Which side did you stand on? Thinking of what you've learned about grace, would you have done anything differently?

6. Grace forces you to be real. Have you been confronted with a circumstance that forced you to be honest with yourself? Did you run or did you face the mirror?

APPLICATION

Grace is stronger than sin. Even when we ourselves don't react with grace, God extends His grace to us. This week, ask God to show you what areas of your life require repentance and acceptance of His grace. Come next week prepared to share.
