DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

- 1. Last week you were asked to identify something you've been afraid to give to God and then give it to Him. You were then asked to just sit there with Him in that moment and be known by Him. Were you able to do that? What happened?
- 2. What is something that stood out to you from David's message this week?
- 3. When God calls us, he leads us into suffering. How does this idea differ from that of the world?
- 4. We are called to step into the suffering of others. What are some tangible ways we might step into the suffering of others? Do you have any personal examples you might share?
- 5. How might entering into the suffering of others increase our reliance on God? How might it strengthen our faith? How might it impact our families for generations to come?

6. God knows the traps that lie ahead. How should this knowledge affect our trust in Him?

APPLICATION

A single moment and a word from the breath of God can change things in an instant. When was the last time you experienced this type of moment and encounter with God? Take some time this week and spend time in the presence God. Ask Him to show you where He is working in the suffering of others and step into that place with Him.
