DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

1. As a disciple of Jesus, are you living out the new creation God has provided for your through the Holy Spirit? Do you see it being expressed, realized, and experienced through your life, family, and/or relationships?

2. Do you find yourself with a foot in step with the Spirit and a foot led by the flesh? Which "seed" seems to be in-charge or leading more often? The Spirit, or the flesh?

3. Are there areas in your life that need more of the Holy Spirit and less of you? Is this something you will share with your group?

4. What do you need to surrender to God?

APPLICATION

Reflect and respond this week and see if you are walking (living) in the flesh or in the Spirit. Our posture says a lot about how we are living. Are you living a life bowed down in humble submission, or living a life in an upright posture doing things under your own power?
