MESSAGE INTRODUCTION

This week we are starting a short sermon series called,
"Words". This series will look at the importance of words
we speak. As new creations we are empowered by the
Spirit of God to live life His way. Part of that life is in the
words we speak and the weight we give the words others
speak over us. This week we will be looking at what
followers of Christ are called to, even when speaking the truth is hard.

Icebreakers

Pick one of the icebreaker questions below and go around in a circle (starting with the leader) and have everyone answer. (If you have new members or guests have each person introduce themselves.)

- 1. If you could create one holiday, what holiday would you create?
- 2. What celebrity endorsement do you not believe they actually use? (such as, Matthew McConaughey actually driving a Lincoln)
- 3. If you could switch places with one of your family members for one day, which family member would you choose, and why?

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

- 1. Last week, we were supposed to be spending time praying for the manifested presence and power of the Holy Spirit to come onto us. In what ways did you experience the Holy Spirit this week?
- 2. Today we started a new series called Words. What stuck out from the sermon which focused on truth?
- 3. Why is it important to respond honestly, even when it seems insignificant? For example, you're reading a book, someone yells downstairs, "what you are doing?" and you respond that you aren't doing anything, instead of saying that you're reading.
- 4. What does it mean to be a new human? What are some characteristics of a new human?
- 5. Matt shared that there are three things that truth brings:

Freedom Redemption Grace God places people in a position to speak truth over you, to build you up, challenge you and help you be all that God wants you to be. Has there been a time where someone has spoken truth over you that brought one of these 3 things? Share with the group how it affected you.

6. Have you ever been a part of a situation where "truth" was shared when it didn't bring freedom, redemption or grace, and in turn, deeply hurt or wounded someone? What can you learn from that situation in watching the words you are speaking to others?

APPLICATION

This week, as you are speaking to others, ask yourself the following questions as you practice speaking truth:

Freedom: Is it bringing relief/ freedom to others?

Redemption: Is it bringing reconciliation? Grace: Is what I am saying showing grace?
