3. Do you see any divisions at New Wine Church that could be worked through (political, social, racial, ideological, etc.)?

4. In what ways can you cultivate greater unity in your local church?

Spend some more time this week thinking about the answers you had for questions 3 and 4. Be prepared to share with the group if there was anything else you came up with that might lead to further division in the church. What are other ways we can recognize and celebrate the differences found in the body of Christ?
