INTRODUCTION

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

4. Can our passed loved ones see / hear / watch us on earth?

6. Thoughts on people's encounters with or stories of paranormal visits?

Read through Revelation chapters 21 & 22. Reflect on the description of final Heaven that God has shown us in this passage.
