MESSAGE INTRODUCTION

This week we continue our sermon series on the Fruit of the Spirit. In this week's message, Ryan explores **Humility** as the essence of goodness and how humility unlocks the path to loving and serving others selflessly.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

- 1. Did something stand out to you from Ryan's message this week on Humility?
- 2. A byproduct of humility is unity. Can you think of any area in your life that is either not united and needs to be (family, relationships, career, etc) OR a time where God has brought unity through humility.
- 3. As followers of Christ, we are marked by having fearlessness and unity (Philippians 1:27, 28). Is there a fear or worry in your life that the small group can pray over right now?
- 4. Being in the same mind, same love, being in full accord and in one mind is to have the same attitude, perspective, and frame of mind as Jesus. How does this resonate with you? Where can you grow in being in one mind, one attitude with the Holy Spirit?

APPLICATION

Reflect on Philippians 2:6-11. Consider Him. Fix your attention on Him. Be in His presence. What is He inviting you to? What is He showing you as you draw near to Him?
