MESSAGE INTRODUCTION

"JESUS IS ALIVE!" That is the message the women heard from the angels when they went to visit the tomb on the 3rd day. In his Easter message, **Jesus Is Alive**, Matt explores the idea of a reveal (1st Day) and a release (3rd

Icebreakers

Pick one of the icebreaker questions below and go around in a circle (starting with the leader) and have everyone answer. (If you have new members or guests have each person introduce themselves.)

- 1. What does your typical Easter menu consist of? Any traditional favorites?
- 2. Have you ever participated in a traditional Seder (Passover) meal? What did you think?
- 3. What is your favorite vegetable? Your least favorite?

Day) and how many Christian find themselves living in the space between the 1st Day and the 3rd Day. Let's dive into the sermon and see how life is released on the 3rd Day and how we move into the 3rd Day and into life.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS (35-45 min)

- 1. Last week you were asked to take time and be intentional in the way you honor Jesus. You were supposed to move move past going through the motions and give Jesus the honor He truly deserves. How did you do? Was anything revealed to you?
- 2. Was there something special that jumped out at you from Matt's Easter message?
- 3. Matt said the 3rd Day was about entering into The Test. What does it mean to enter The Test? How was Jesus tested? How are we tested?
- 4. The 3rd Day is also about the "release" the release of life. Compare the events in Genesis 1:3-31 and Luke 22:66 24:6 and how they show the "reveal" on the 1st Day and the "release" on the 3rd Day. What promise is available for us in the 3rd Day (Resurrection Day)?

APPLICATION

Have you experienced the "release" of the 3rd Day? Maybe you need to experience it again. Jesus calls us to lay down our life in order to receive a new life. If you've made that decision, take a moment to reflect on what

that truly means to you. If you haven't made that choice, now is the perfect time to lay down your life, receive the life that Jesus offers, and follow Him.
