Orphan and Foster Care Statistics

- 143,000-153,000
 orphans
 worldwide
- 5,700 children
 become orphans
 every day
 A child ages out of
 the system every
 2.2 seconds
- 420,000 children in foster care
- Child enters foster care every6.6 seconds
- 20,000 youth age out every year
- 1 in 4 do not graduate/GED
- Less than 3% college degree
- 1/2 of homeless population are former foster youth
- 10-15% of orphans commit suicide by age 18

- Children belong in families
- Foster care is a church problem
- Orphan care is a gospel issue
- Orphan care is about obedience and expressing the heart of God
- Foster care and adoption can be seen as part of the Great Commission
- We are not all called to the same thing, but we can all do something
- It takes a Church to raise a child
