Jesus Christ is the Better Sacrifice (Hebrews 10:1-18)

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places, even as he chose us in him ***before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and blameless before him***. In love he predestined us for adoption to himself as sons through Jesus Christ, according to the purpose of his **will**... In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of his grace...

Sacrifices by the Priests	Sacrifice of Jesus Christ
Every priest	Jesus Christ
Daily, Repeatedly	Sacrifice once for all time
Priest stands, still working	Jesus Christ sits, waiting
Can never take away sins	Takes away sins; Perfects believers

Completion of the Argument – Jesus Christ is the Better Sacrifice (Hebrews 10:1-18)

Perfect = justified = made righteous before God

Yet we know that a person is not *justified* by works of the law but through faith in Jesus Christ, so we also have believed in Christ Jesus, in order to be justified by faith in Christ and not by works of the law, because by works of the law no one will be justified.

Galatians 3:16

And to the one who does not work but believes in him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is counted as righteousness.

Living in Deliberate Sin and Faithlessness

Characteristics of lifestyle?

- Continues in deliberate sin
- Denies Jesus Christ and purity and sufficiency of His sacrifice
- Shrinks back

Expectation for the future?

- No sacrifice to take away their sins (vs 26)
- Judgement, fury of fire (vs 27)
- Worse punishment than physical death (vs 28-29)
- Vengeance and judgement from God (vs 30-31)
- Destruction (vs 39)

Living in Faithful Endurance

Characteristics of lifestyle?

- Endures persecution joyfully because of hope (vs 32-34)
- Hold fast to their faith (vs 34-35)
- Needs endurance (vs 35)
- Lives by faith (vs 38-39)

Expectation for the future?

- A better possession and an abiding one (vs 34)
- Great reward (vs 35)
- Will receive what is promised (vs 36)
- Souls are preserved (vs 39)
