Ephesians 6:16-20

¹⁶In <u>all</u> circumstances take up the shield of faith, with which you can extinguish <u>all</u> the flaming darts of the evil one; ¹⁷and take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God, ¹⁸praying at <u>all</u> times in the Spirit, with <u>all</u> prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with <u>all</u> perseverance, making supplication for <u>all</u> the saints, ¹⁹and also for me, that words may be given to me in opening my mouth boldly to proclaim the mystery of the gospel. ²⁰for which I am an ambassador in chains.

Hebrews 4:14-16

¹⁴Since then we have a great high priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus, the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. ¹⁵For we do not have a high priest who is unable to sympathize with our weaknesses, but one who in every respect has been tempted as we are, yet without sin.¹⁶Let us then with confidence draw near to the throne of grace, that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need.
