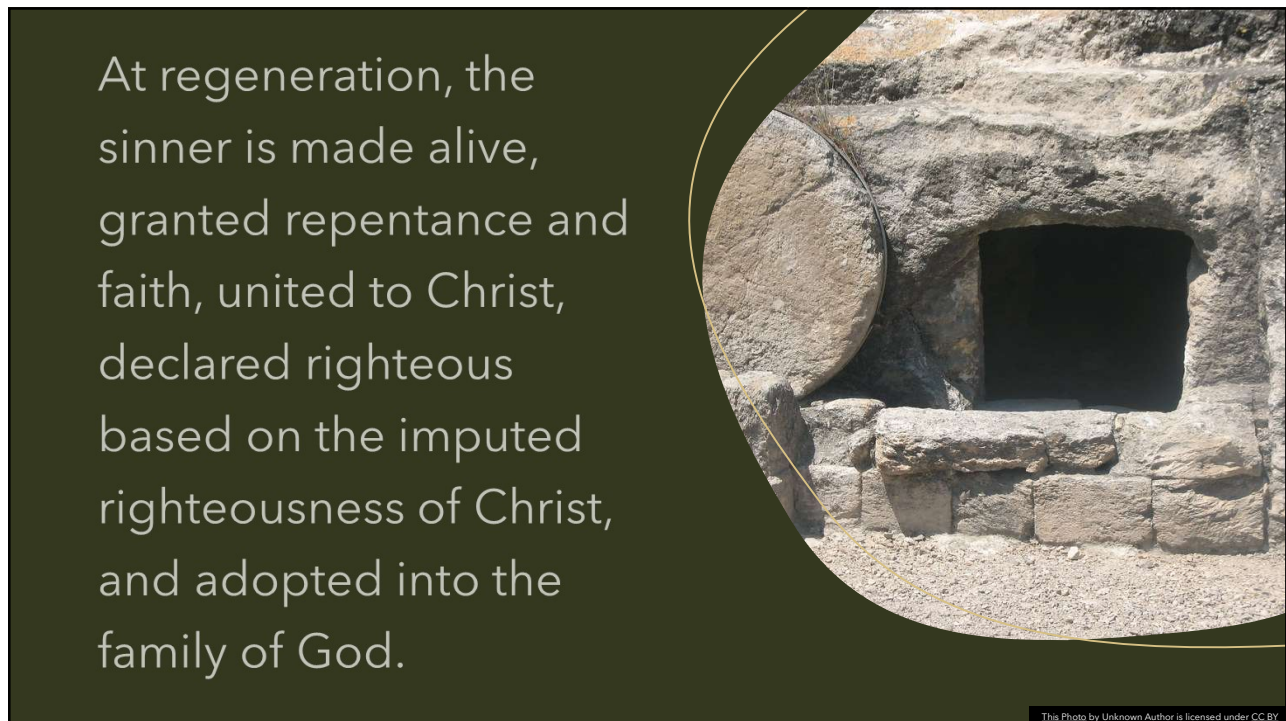




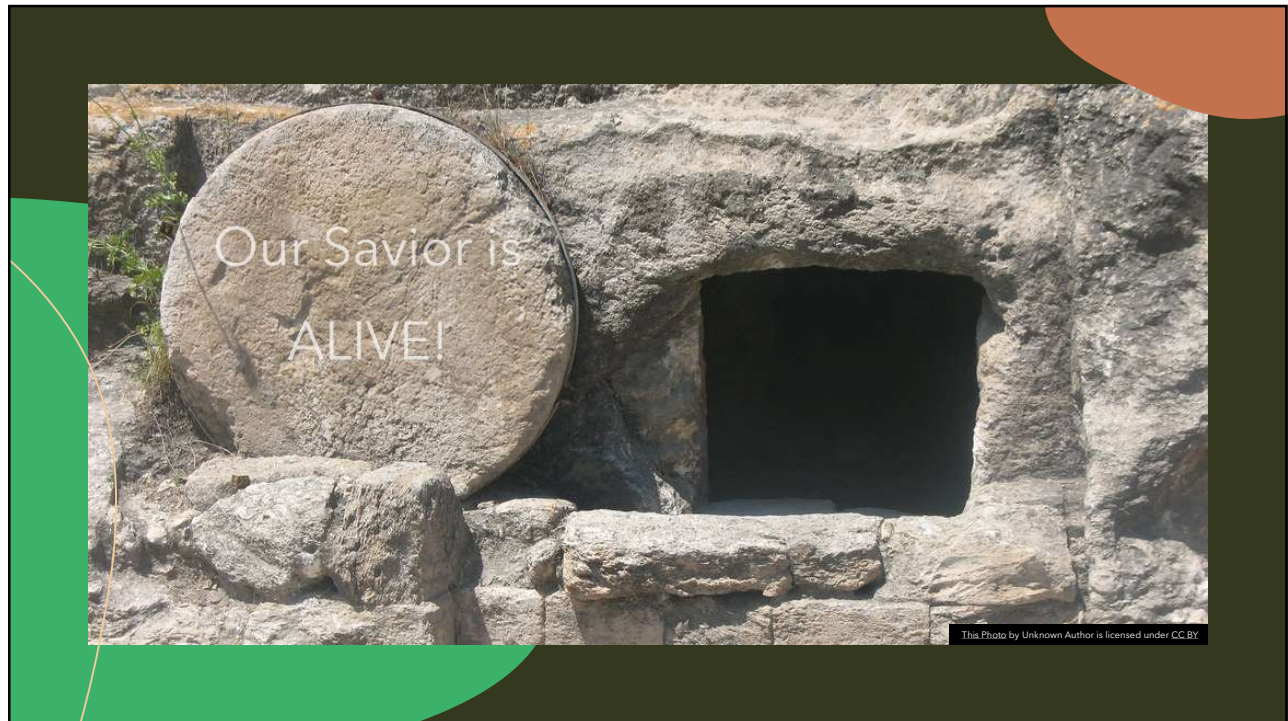

Defining Sanctification

Hagiazō - to make, render or declare holy; to separate from things profane and dedicate to God, to consecrate.

Stage 1: Positional Sanctification

The believer is set free from the *penalty AND power* of sin.

Although our sin nature remains, we battle from a position of victory.
