### ***A New Creation in Christ***

2 Corinthians 5: 16 – 17, Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new. –NKJV

1 John 3: 1, Behold what manner of love the Father has bestowed on us, that we should be called children of God! Therefore the world does not know us, because it did not know Him, -NKJV

The Word of God is the final authority on all things pertaining to life and godliness. As Christians, we are to hold fast to God's Word no matter what we hear from people. The Word of God teaches us who we are once we become born again by the Spirit of God. After we accept Jesus as our Savior and Lord, we become new creatures in Christ.

Please meditate a moment on the principle of being born again. If we are born again as believers in Jesus, that means that we're made new. Being born again means so much more than having a new start in life, it also means that we are different as before salvation. If you are born again, you are a spiritual being (child of God) now and not just a human being.

As a child of God, you have eternal life residing in you because God's Spirit dwells in you. When a person is born again, the world no longer knows them according to John's teaching. Paul also teaches the same principle as John. In his letter, Paul tells us that although we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. What does all this mean to us?

Have you noticed that Christians are treated differently by the world? Christians, like Christ, are hated by all nations just as Jesus said we would be. But why? We are spirit beings filled with God's Spirit. That makes us completely different than all other humans on earth. If you think about it for a moment, this only confirms even more that we are born again of the Spirit because we are treated differently.

John also teaches us when we are born again, the world does not know us. John explains wonderfully why Christians are rejected and looked down upon by the world. It's because they don't know us, in the same way the world doesn't know our heavenly Father or Jesus Christ.

When you accepted Jesus into your heart and life, your old identity died along with your past sin. Consequently, no one really knows you as a child of God, even though they may be related to you in the natural. In fact, we don't even know who we are once we become born again. This is why we need to fully rely on God's Word and His Spirit to reveal to us who we are now that we're born again. This will require us to develop and maintain a personal relationship with the Lord.

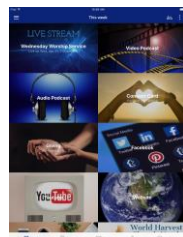

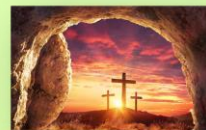
