Over the Christmas holiday, WHCN sent funds to Johnson Peter of Lahore, Pakistan. I had mentioned the great need of the children in a previous service. Johnson had sent us pictures of impoverished children who are forced to make bricks with their parents to pay off debts. You may remember, I shared a story of a woman who had to work to provide for her family because her husband became terribly ill, and they needed medicine.

She was forced to borrow money from individuals that also run a brick kiln where bricks are produced. Unfortunately, these individuals take advantage of people who find themselves in situations such as hers. Because she does not earn enough to pay off the debt for medications and other necessities, they add interest onto her debt, which makes it almost impossible to pay off her original debt.

It is for reasons such as this one which I have shared with you that children are subjected to hard labor to help their parents pay off their debts. There are more than 140 children who are trapped in this type of situation. The children do not have adequate clothing such as shoes to wear to protect their feet in the harsh environment where they work.

Because of your gifts to missions, we were able to send \$500.00, which was used to purchase shoes, clothing, and presents for Christmas to give to them. We realize that the need is far greater than our ability to provide. However, for the children who received help, they were shown the love of Jesus through your gifts of support. It is the plan of Johnson Peter and his wife to soon open a Christian school to help the children to learn about Jesus while living in a Muslim Country. Thank you to everyone who supports the missions' outreaches of WHCN.
