ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning, [child's name]! It's time to wake up! God has plans for us, and we know God's plans are best!"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, Thank You for the story of King Josiah. Please help [child's name] and me do what You say, because Your plans are best."



Drive Time

While on the go, look for road signs and talk about what they mean. Say: "We do what road signs say, because they are best for us. When King Josiah's workers found the scroll with God's words on it, he did what it said, because he knew God's plans are best!"



Bath Time

Add a crown to bath time. Let your child wear it while they bathe. Talk about how King Josiah's workers found a scroll with God's words on it. When King Josiah heard God's words, he did what God said because He knew God's plans are best.
