## Morning Time

At a meal this week, have everyone answer this question: “What is something you’ve read in the Bible, heard in a song, or listened to in a message at church that had a big impact on you?”

## Bed Time

Pray for each other: “Dear God, thank You for Your Word. Help us not just read it, but understand it and let it shape our lives. Show us more of who You are as we spend time in Your Word, the Bible.”
