### **Psalm 119:105 (NIV)**

<sup>105</sup> Your word is a lamp for my feet,  
a light on my path.

### **James 1:5 (NIV)**

<sup>5</sup> If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you.

Ask the group what stood out to them in the text.

## **Discussion Questions**

1. The video opened with an illustration on how God leads us similar to a GPS. How is finding God's will similar to using a GPS? Have you ever felt like God "recalculated" your life when you made a wrong turn?
2. Share about a time when a verse or passage of Scripture gave you clarity in making a decision. What happened?
3. Pastor Smart mentioned decisions like marriage, conflict, and career. What are some common decisions people in our group face today where we really need to seek God's will?

4. What does it look or feel like for you when the Holy Spirit leads you? How do you tell the difference between God's leading and just your own emotions?
5. The video also discussed seeking wise counsel. Who has been a godly counselor in your life? What's one piece of advice they gave you that helped you clearly see God's will?

As you go through this week, go through this process in your decision making, what does God's word say? If we don't find clarity there, what is His Spirit leading me to do? And if we are still unclear, who can I get wise counsel from?
